Project Background

In 2016 the Souris Basin Planning Council adopted a Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) that highlights land use conflicts between Minot Air Force Base and other jurisdictions within its influence. This document formulated strategies to address conflicts that could impact the vital mission of the US Air Force, which have emerged due to the sensitive nature of USAF activities, the rapid proliferation of oil and gas extraction in Western North Dakota, and accompanying development pressures throughout the region.

Building on the success of the JLUS, Souris Basin Planning Council and a consultant team are initiating a follow-up planning process. The JLUS Implementation Plan will emphasize training to assist jurisdictions in producing local plans and increasing local awareness of US Air Force facilities, all in order to respond to common goals identified in the JLUS.
